

Awards for Volunteer Heroes

The LTVCA is calling for nominations for its annual 'Awards for Volunteer Heroes.' These awards honour and recognize those in the community for their outstanding volunteer time and services towards conservation activities that educate about or improve our natural environment, and ultimately the health and quality of life in the Lower Thames watershed.

We wish to celebrate and recognize their volunteerism at activities which could include but are not limited to:

- Environmental education
- Special events
- Board and committee work

The winners are invited to the Annual General Meeting in February for a ceremony to recognize their efforts, they also receive a pin, certificate and are recognized in the Annual Report.

The Awards for Volunteer Heroes' Nomination Form is found on the next page. The nominations close on the second Friday of each December. Please note that past winners of the LTVCA's 'Awards for Volunteer Heroes' are not eligible to receive this award a second time.

Nominations may be made by the general public, LTVCA Directors and/or staff.

Nominations are reviewed and evaluated by the 'Awards for Volunteer Heroes' Committee. Up to four nominations are selected each year. 'Awards for Volunteer Heroes' recipients will be notified.

LTVCA 'Awards for Volunteer Heroes' Criteria

Criteria: Nominees should have demonstrated extensive volunteerism over an extended period of time in areas of conservation service within the Lower Thames Valley Conservation Authority's watershed and region.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be 14 years of age or older
- Nominees must be a resident from one of the 10 member municipalities of the Lower Thames Valley Conservation Authority (*Chatham-Kent, Lakeshore, Leamington, Dutton Dunwich, West Elgin, Southwold, Middlesex Centre, Strathroy-Caradoc, Southwest Middlesex, London*)
- Nominations must include details on the volunteerism of the organization, or individual and duration of service in an area of conservation in the LTVCA watershed and region
