Ska-Nah-Doht Advisory Committee Members Job Description

1. The Ska-Nah-Doht Advisory Committee provides advice and is accountable to the Board of Directors of the Lower Thames Valley Conservation Authority.
2. A term of office is 3 years. Members may serve 2 consecutive terms (6 years). An additional term of 3 years may be held as a member of the committee following a hiatus of 1 year.
3. Attend committee meetings: the committee meets 4 times per year with meetings up to 2 hours in length. Subcommittees meet as needed throughout the year.
4. Make a serious commitment to participate actively in committee work.
5. Participate in fundraising for the organization.
6. Actively promote the values and standards of the Museum in adherence to Municipal, Provincial and Federal laws and policies.
7. Serve without remuneration.
